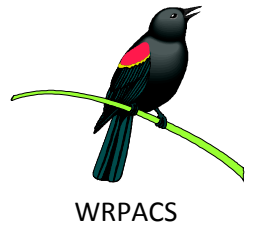


Kiss & Ride Program



A convenient and safe way
to drop off your child in the morning

Time:

- The Kiss and Ride program runs between 8:10 am and 8:25 am.

Procedures

- Enter the driveway at the entrance on Watson Road. The traffic flow through the front driveway will be one-way only – from Watson Road to Yates Road.
- The two lanes into the driveway will be clearly marked by pylons. One will be Bus Lane only; the other will be the Kiss and Ride lane.
- Proceed into the Kiss and Ride lane.
- Follow the Kiss and Ride lane to the drop off point or points. **ONLY AT THE DROP OFF POINT ARE CHILDREN ALLOWED TO GET OUT.**
- A large orange cone will be present beside the “Kiss and Ride” drop off point to indicate where to stop your car and deliver passengers.
- Children should be ready to exit your vehicle with knapsacks etc. in hand.
- Children (with assistance from volunteers) must exit from the right side of the vehicle without the driver getting out of the vehicle and proceed towards the designated walkway.
- After the children are safely out of your vehicle, you may proceed and leave the driveway through the Yates Road exit.
- Between 8:00 am and 8:30 am, there are no LEFT turns onto Yates Road at the exit. Turn right onto Yates Road; follow Yates Road to Ballou Road; turn right on Ballou to get to Glenmore Road.

Other information:

- Students will enter the school at the bell or as per usual procedures. Before the bell rings, there is to be NO loitering or playing in front of the school.
- During the Kiss and Ride operation times, the parking lot will be designated for staff and handicapped only. Parents who do not want to use the Kiss and Ride will not have plenty of legal parking on the street where they can park and then walk their children onto school property.
